**OPERATIONAL SUPPORT**

**(i.e. VE, PE, etc.):**

- \_\_\_ a. 2 **FD-258** Fingerprint Cards with original signatures completely filled out?
- \_\_\_ b. 1 **SF Form 85, (page 6 only)** Authorization for Release of Information with original signature completely filled out?
- \_\_\_ c. 1 **OFI Form 86C** Special Agreement Check (SAC) that includes blanks for mother's full name, maiden name, and father's full name completely filled out?
- \_\_\_ d. 1 **US Citizenship Verification** Is verification form completed? Copy of document included?

Regarding citizenship verification; Only the documents listed on the verification form are acceptable (note that a military IDs and driver's licenses re NOT proof of US citizenship). However, if the Auxiliary officer does not know you personally, you must also show a photo ID to prove it is your verification document.

Regarding fingerprinting; it is recommended that you are fingerprinted by a designated CG Auxiliary fingerprint technician. However, you may be fingerprinted by your local police department, BUT, you must obtain the appropriate US Government finger print cards from the CG Auxiliary. The fingerprint cards used by law enforcement agencies are different and are NOT acceptable.
